



CHANNEL 44 BEGINS TRANSMISSIONS *"Everybody's signal"*

Will be able to tune in open television in all Guadalajara's Metropolitan Zone starting January 31.

The Federal Telecommunications Commission granted the permit to operate an open television signal from Guadalajara's University.

The location of the transmitting plant at Cerro del Cuatro was determined in function of the coverage requested by the University, same that covers Guadalajara's metropolitan area and some adjacent townships.

The broadcast tower that holds Channel 44 antena was placed 1,848 meters above sea level.

Channel 44 has an authorized output that allows a transmition signal that reaches a 70 kilometers radius, fromour broadcast tower in Cerro del Cuatro, Tlaquepaque, wich measures a hundred meters height and has a mast where the 10 meter anthenas are placed.

Guadalajara's open television has the purpose of producing, coproducing, acquire and alienate emission rights on television programs and, in general, to perform and hire programs under any modality, even in association, that has emphasis in programs with quality themes and contents for the audience.



Channel 44 is the result of the work of many university students for over a decade.

There are five mexican institutions of superior education that have television channels.



National Polytechnic Institute (Once TV, channel 11); UNAM (UNAM Tv, channel 20); Autonomus Spain University of Durango (XHUNES, channel 28); Autonomus University of Nuevo León (XHMNU, channel 53); and Sonora University (XHUS, channel 8).

For their national presence and contents, the televisual offers of CONACULTA channel 22, UNAM Tv and Once Tv from the National Polytechnic Institute (IPN) stand out.

Some of these signals got their permits decades ago. IPN's channel 11 is actually Latin America University televisions' dean, same as the oldest public service television of this continent's area, started it's transmitions in 1959. Sonora's University Station broadcasts since December 1965. Channel 53 of Nuevo León's Autonomus University operates since 1990 and UNAM TV since 2005.

Starting January 31st, 2011, XHUDG-TV Channel 44, officialy beggins it's transmitions in Guadalajara's metropolitan area. For you we make different television. Channel 44, everybody's signal.

Produced by UNAM, will be transmitted the programs La Victrola, Mexico arrival door (México puerta de Ilegada) and Science What for? (Ciencia ¿para qué?).

The linkings will be made with channel 22 with the programs La Dichosa palabra (The well known word), Huellas del tiempo (Time tracks), Pueblos indígenas hoy (Today's Native towns)), A la mesa! 

"Guardian Angels a non governmental is organization (NGO) that peruits activating the citizens in actions focused in its neighbourhood, through public spaces restoration, such as schools, malls and gardens, conservation of these, and coordinated surveillance with the community authorities in order to lower the criminal rates.

The founding project was created in 1979 in New York City in the Bronx. Citizen Curtis Sliwa organized a group of neighbors who were sick of the crime and insecurity they were living in their community.

Taking from there "Guardian Angels" was born and started to develop programs intended to reinstate public spaces and to organize citizen help groups that would inhibit the crime.

Thirty years from its foundation, "guardian Angels" is present in more than 13 countries, 138 cities, and counts with more than 55 thousand volunteers, as a successfull citizen participation, achieving to lower the crime in conflit cities like New York and Chicago.

In Mexico's city, Ian Ho Hodgkinson has manager the chapters since 2006, having presence in 18 neighborhoods of high social poverty. The Exquisit Cadaver tecnique has been adapted to drawings and

collages, and today to TV, maybe inspired in children's illustrations in which the pages where divided into three parts (the upper third would show a persons head or animal, the middle third the torso and the bottom thirs the legs).

The children had the ability to mix and match the figures by flipping the pages.

It can also be sent by mail a drawing or collage to the players –by progressive stages- this is known as "Exquisit Mail Cadaver" (apparently, it doesn't matter if the game travels through mail or not).

Some have played the game with a drawing game with an agreement of what could be the result of the ilustration, something that could be considered a contradiction of the game's surrealistic nature.

The game has been

adapted to be used for computers graphics, to construct surreal objects, and even an adaptation for architectural proposals.



1.- look on your TV's menu the cable or anthena option (IRC), make sure you out it in anthena mode.

2.- It is recommended to buy an antena difusor and connect this to your cable. This divice will allow you to have both cable and open TV connected. You will only have to select what kind of signal you wish to watch.

If you have digital service (HD)

1.- look for the option for selecting between analog and digital channels and make sure you have it in analog.

2.- Some TVs, even when you have connected the anthena or the hired cable services you must have

your TV in anthena mode. It will be necessary lo choose the self-programming, scan, or search for the channeld automatically.

After choosing this option your TV will search for the channels that have a good reception level and will automatically save them, so when you change the channels with your remote they will be available.

This process may take a couple minutes, dependind on the TV model. When this process is finished you will be able to enjoy Channel 44.
